Board policy is defined as a statement of principle, in alignment with district goals and objectives, which the board adopts to outline a course of action. The purpose of board policy is to define responsibilities and incorporate routine decisions into written form.

Administrative rules are established through the administrative staff and are used primarily as administrative guidelines in various aspects of school administrative responsibilities. Administrative rules, detailed directives that are used to put policy into effect, are not officially adopted by the school board, except when required by law or board policy to do so.
