Board of Education Policy

FULL TIME STUDENTS

I. ELEMENTARY

Elementary students in grades K-8 shall be considered to be full time students when they are scheduled to be in attendance at a full time basis at their respective grade levels for the normal school day between the hours when classes are scheduled to meet.

II. HIGH SCHOOL, GRADES 9-12

A student enrolled in John Edwards High School will be considered a full time student if the student averages three approved classes per year or is enrolled as a special student classification including special education program.

III. ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION

Students enrolled or participating in any alternative educational programs or program or curriculum modifications shall be considered a full time student. Students in this category include, but are not limited to, children at risk, truants, school-age parents, and students who are excused from school attendance to participate in a program leading to high school graduation or high school equivalency. Students attending a nonresident public school district on a full time basis under the open enrollment law are considered full time students in the resident district for state aid purposes.
