Board of Education Policy

MUSICAL INSTRUMENT RENTAL

Students requesting the use of school owned musical instruments will be assessed a non-refundable user fee to be set annually by the Board of Education and published in the student handbook. Students will also be responsible for payment of any damage to the instrument caused through negligence or wear which is beyond that which would be considered normal. Students sharing the use of a school-owned instrument will both be assessed the user's fee. Both will be accountable for damages to the instrument.

Rental fees will be waived for any student whose family is economically disadvantaged as determined by federal free and reduced lunch standards.

Any student that is using a school instrument at the request of the instructor will not be assessed the user fee but will be responsible for payment of damages to that instrument.

A signed agreement will be required for school rentals.

**RENTAL AGREEMENT
