Board of Education Policy

NO TRESPASSING ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

A. GROUNDS

There will be no trespassing on school property from south of the basketball courts located north of the grade 5-12 school building bounded on the west by Third Street, on the east by Second Street, on the south by LaVigne Avenue and the area immediately adjacent to the elementary school building located on Fifth Street excluding playground equipment. There will be no trespassing on the high school bleacher area located on Third Street. Exceptions are for legitimate school activities. School activities are defined as those activities carried out with school knowledge and approval. Examples of, but not limited to, such activities are athletics, car washes, little league, YMCA programs, etc. The trespassing policy is in effect:

1. on school days between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 7:30 a.m., and,
2. at all times on days when school is not in session.

B. BUILDINGS

Any person not in official attendance or on official school business shall not enter into, congregate, wander, stroll, or stand in any school building in the Port Edwards district. Any person in the building on official business shall register in the building office.
