TITLE I PROGRAM – PARENT INVOLVEMENT

The Port Edwards School District values parent involvement in the educational process. Parents of Title I students are invited to assist the District in providing the best educational program for students who are performing below grade level in reading and mathematics. The District will facilitate this collaboration by:

- Developing a Title I Steering Committee to give input on policies and procedures affecting Title students.
- Holding an annual meeting in the fall and a planning meeting in the spring. Parents, administration and board members will be invited. The meeting agendas will include opportunities for parents to make recommendations.
- Offering at least two parent/student activities during the school year.
- Making regular reports to parents concerning student achievement and assessment.
- Providing parents with practical information on learning strategies to use at home.
- Providing substantiation that the Title I teachers and paraprofessionals are highly qualified.
- Making information about Title I curriculum and assessments available to parents at Parent Teacher Conferences, Open House, and Title I activities.
- Using a parent-school compact.
- Ensuring that all services provided for Title I students shall be at least comparable to those provided in areas not receiving Title I funds.

It is the mission of the Title I program to encourage parent participation in the program development and activities. Communications to parents will be drafted in easily understood language and interpreters will be provided when necessary.
